Students should arrive at school **on time**.

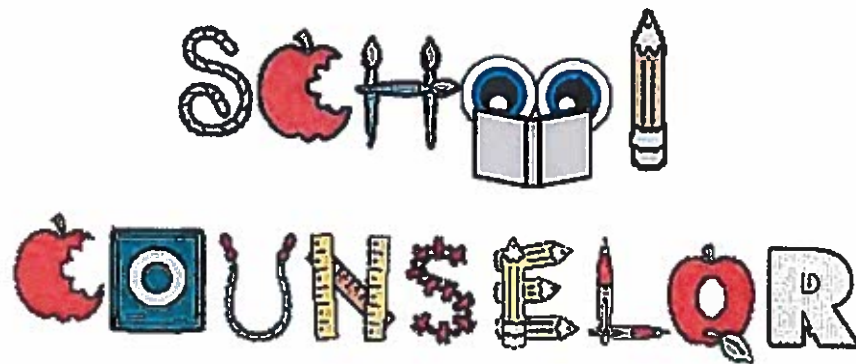
Seniors – DO NOT HAVE SCHOOL

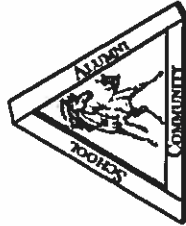
