As per House Bill (HB) 4025 (**Public Act 99-0434**) the legislature of Illinois now requires ALL students to take a course in Civics, which you will do during your senior year. One of the requirements of the course is that students complete community service hours to develop a sense of ownership of your community.

The specific course requirement at EPCHS are 8 hours of Community Service AND 2 Governmental Meetings Attended OR 5 Community Service Hours AND 3 Governmental Meetings. You will also hit one benchmark towards being “College Ready” under the new ESSA College and Career Readiness Indicator if you earn up to 25 hours.

This year, you will be given instructions on how to record your service hours using the online platform Career Cruising by the guidance counselors. In the meantime, you can use this form to record any community service or governmental meetings you might attend during your Civics Course. **Please return completed forms BY THE END OF YOUR CIVICS COURSE.**

Please keep a copy for your counselor/student records. Digital copies are fine but you **MUST** include contact information for an adult supervisor.

A Few Things to Remember:

- Volunteering should be focused in and around our EP/Chicagoland Community, but mission trips qualify also.
- Non-Profit Organizations (Charities), Schools, Libraries, Hospitals, Elder Care Facilities, Religious and Civic Organizations are all great places to look to volunteer.
- You are able to meet PART of the requirement at governmental meetings (School Board, Park District, or City/Village Council)
- **If there is no evidence of completion or contact information the experience will NOT count.**
- **You MAY choose to take a selfie of your performing your service and send it to your teacher.**
